A Blast From the Past



Taken from Historic Florissant archives, Cross Keys Missouri started with a German owned blacksmith shop around 1840. The shop was the only blacksmith North of St Louis at the time. It was named Cross Keys, because there were three towns that met on each corner of and Cross Keys was the fourth. This could have been the early start of North St. Louis County.

Harry and Matthilda Rosenkoetter opened their store in Cross Keys Missouri, in 1914. This popular place drew customers from Florissant, Black Jack and Spanish Lake. This photo was taken in 1940 and shows the wonderful old gas pumps out front. There was a tavern inside which had a separate entrance at the end of the building.
